Sixth Ward Mission

Members of **GO-EDC** recognize that an attractive community is critical to its overall economic development. It supports the image of community and paints a picture of economic vitality. **GO-EDC** also recognizes that taking-on a municipal-wide beautification project for Oneonta would be beyond its current capability. In that regard, it was decided to concentrate on the 6th Ward of Oneonta to try and create a precedent example, a model if you will, for other neighborhoods of the community to follow. It was decided to concentrate on the 6th Ward for a variety of reasons: 1] the neighborhood is geographically more defined; 2] that an effort was already initiated through a neighborhood banner program by Linda Gilmore and 3] both Colone and Shue are residents there.
